**WANZEK JOINS ELITE CRANE-OWNING CONSTRUCTION FIRMS  
ACT 50 Lists North America's Largest Companies**

**Fargo, N.D.** (June 12, 2007) – Wanzek Construction, a Fargo, N.D.-based heavy and industrial construction firm, has cracked into “ACT 50,” a list of North America’s 50 largest crane-owning companies. Wanzek makes its debut at number 48 on the prestigious list, compiled by *American Cranes & Transport* magazine and published annually in June.

Jon Wanzek, owner and executive vice president, said inclusion on the list demonstrates both the company’s financial strength and its dedication to serving customers. “Wanzek has made a concerted effort to build a crane fleet that allows us to be where our customers need us when they need us with the right equipment needed to do the job,” said Wanzek. “We’re excited about being ranked among the country’s elite companies, and we look forward to moving up on the ACT 50 as our explosive growth continues.”

The ACT 50 counts all crawler and mobile cranes in a fleet and adds the tonnage each can lift to get an “ACT Index.” Wanzek’s ACT Index is 2,450.

Only cranes in Wanzek’s fleet as of May 1, 2007 could be counted. Since then, the company has added four cranes with rigging capacities of 200, 275, 550 and 660 tons, so it likely will make considerable gains on the June 2008 list.

Wanzek, a family-owned construction firm founded in 1971, specializes in heavy and industrial projects throughout North America, including agricultural processing,
